DC acts in a transversal way in the field of Visual Arts. For nine years she has been a mediator in exhibition spaces at art institutions. She delivered lectures in Vevey and Lausanne, in Switzerland. She dedicates herself to the project Seus filhos também praticam, in which she uses prostitution as

a tool for work and research by approaching white, wealthy and self-declared straight young men between the ages of 18 and 25. In this project, she seeks to nourish the dialogue and the listening in the domain of race, class, gender and sexuality.

She owns a Bachelor's degree in Visual Arts (FAAP), with a Master's degree obtained in the United States (Ohio University) and studies in England and New Zealand. The artist proposes as her poetics that her life is art and decides to draw mind maps in books at the end of every day, since 1988, as an evidence of her

being alive. This routine unfolds in different supports as a record of her drifts around the world. Grande tela (1989), Grande tela (1990) and O espectro de cor da minha vida (1989) are part of the MAC USP collection.

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
# São Paulo Companhia de Dança
